To Whom It May Concern,

The parade will take place on September 9th at 9:00 a.m. Even though we still have months to go, keep in mind it takes time to prepare for the parade. This year's theme will be "95 Years of Memories in Ivins".

There is no charge to enter the parade. Application must be submitted by September 1st to leave time for us to make the necessary preparations to accommodate all entries. Parade scripts should be kept under 10 seconds to allow the flow of traffic to continue steadily and should be turned in with your application.

The parade will start at 9:00 am. **ALL parade entries should be** <u>in line</u> and <u>ready to go</u> no later than 8:45 am. Please call approximately one (1) week prior to find out what entry number you will be and where you need to line up. If you have more than one entry that will not fit within the numbered space, then you will be instructed to have a leader stay in the number location at the start up and all the other participants will line up alongside the lead entry. Please be on time.

All entries should have the magnetic number on the front quarter panel or visible on the driver's side of the car. After the parade someone will be collecting the numbers, please do not leave without handing in your number to a City official. The route will continue at a slow pace and entries should stay at least 50 feet from the entry in front of them to give room for any problems that may occur. **Candy will be allowed, but must be handed out by people walking along curbside to avoid children running into the street.** We invite groups to get creative in their parade entries. You don't have to stick to a float, you could form a Precision Marching Team using such items as shopping carts, brief cases, baskets, balls, or any item that might represent your group. You could have music, or sing, perform a dance or musical number, etc... We want to provide our spectators with more variety and entertainment this year. **If you know a Marching Band that would like to participate, have them contact us.**

Please join Ivins City in celebrating our heritage and community spirit. Everyone is invited.
