## **About the Bus**

We will be traveling in a luxury coach from St George Shuttle. The bus will be handicap accessible with a wheelchair lift/strap in. The main entrance to the bus will have approx. 4 steps, with handrails.

The bus will have room for additional storage underneath. Please note that you will not have access to these items while we are driving. The additional storage will only be opened when we stop. There will be room to store large items, such as walkers/wheelchairs (again, if not needed while we are driving).

The bus **will** have a bathroom. We will not stop for the restroom between Ivins and Cedar City on the way there or on the way back.

The bus will have wifi and charging ports, if you would like to bring/use your electronics on the drive. If you would like to contribute, at the end of the drive, we will pass around for a tip for the driver.

## **Food**

We will provide water bottles and snacks on the way there and back. Please plan to either bring or purchase your own lunch.

## **Weather/Dress**

The weather in Cedar City is not as hot as Ivins in the summer. The average daily high for mid-July is usually about 85 degrees.

There is no dress code. Many choose to wear casual attire.

The Randall L Jones Theatre is indoors. It is recommended to bring a sweater or light jacket as the indoor Randall L. Jones Theatre may be cooler than some find comfortable.

The buildings on the Shakespeare campus are not fully connected, meaning some walking outdoors between buildings, such as meeting by an outdoor statue for the Backstage Tour.

## **Things to Do at the Shakespeare Festival**

### **Backstage Tour – included in registration fee**

Peek behind the scenery and into the Festival's various production areas to see how all the enchantment comes together. These informative tours are led by Festival actors and artists who can share their backstage knowledge with you.

Participants must navigate stairs. Tour will go up at least one full flight of stairs, possibly two.

### **Meet at "The Fred Statue" in the Engelstad Shakespeare Theatre Courtyard**

**10am** - Tours start promptly at 10:00 a.m. Late arrivals may not be able to join a tour in progress.

### **Something Rotten! – included in registration fee**

*Something Rotten!* is a hilarious, high-energy musical that reimagines Shakespeare's world with a modern twist. Set in the Renaissance, it follows struggling playwrights Nick and Nigel Bottom, who try to outshine wildly popular William Shakespeare by creating the world's first musical. Packed with show-stopping numbers, outrageous comedy, and clever nods to Broadway and the Bard, *Something Rotten!* is a joyful celebration of creativity, ambition, and the absurdity of the theatre world.
